The last Mega Millions jackpot was won at \$810 million (\$409.3 million cash value) on September 10, 2024. The sole winning ticket was sold in Texas.

Did You Know?

- Friday’s jackpot is the 8th largest in Mega Millions history.
- A Mega Millions jackpot has been won on a Friday the 13th [seven times](#). The last was on January 13, 2023, when a \$1.348 billion prize was won in Maine. Michigan has been particularly lucky on this unlucky day, with four winning jackpots over the years. The remaining two Friday the 13th jackpots won were in New York and in Ohio.

NOTE: Prizes in California are paid on a pari-mutuel basis and differ from fixed prize amounts.

- Mega Millions is the only lottery game that has produced six jackpots greater than \$1 billion. All were won in different states – South Carolina was the first in 2018, followed by Michigan in 2021, Illinois in 2022, Maine in January 2023, Florida in August 2023 and New Jersey in March 2024.
- The largest iLottery jackpot win in U.S. history was for the \$552 million Mega Millions jackpot on June 4, 2024, with one winning ticket sold in Illinois via the lottery’s mobile app.
- The Mega Millions jackpot was hit 10 times in 2023 and three times so far in 2024.

General Information

Game Facts

- **Where to Buy:** Mega Millions tickets are sold in 47 jurisdictions: 45 states; Washington, D.C., and the U.S. Virgin Islands.
- **Ticket Price:** Tickets are \$2; The Megaplier option is an additional \$1. Prizes on all Megaplier tickets are multiplied, except for the jackpot.
- **Drawing Time:** Drawings are conducted at 11 p.m. Eastern Time on Tuesdays and Fridays in Atlanta, GA.
- **Starting Jackpot:** The starting jackpot for the next drawing after a jackpot-winning Mega Millions ticket is sold is currently \$20 million but can vary depending on game sales and interest rates. There is no fixed minimum jackpot roll increase, which also is dependent on game sales and interest rates.
- **Game Odds:** Overall chances of winning any prize: 1 in 24. Odds of winning the jackpot: 1 in 303 million.
- **How to Play:** Players select five numbers from 1 to 70 and one Mega Ball number from 1 to 25. There are [nine prize tiers](#), ranging from \$2 to the jackpot.
- **Annuity:** A jackpot winner who opts for the annuity receives one immediate payment and annual payments that increase by 5% per year for 29 years.
- **Estimated Values:** Estimated annuity and cash values are announced prior to drawing dates and are based on projected sales. Differences between the estimates and final amounts may occur if a substantial percentage of sales happen on the drawing date. The cash value is the amount of cash in the jackpot pool. If a winner chooses the annuity, the cash value is used to buy bonds that fund the annual payments.

Game History

- **Game Name:** Mega Millions originally launched as “The Big Game,” with its first drawing on Sept. 6, 1996. Its name was changed to Mega Millions in 2002.
- **First Drawing:** The first Mega Millions drawing was held on May 17, 2002, and produced a \$28 million jackpot winner from Illinois.

Who Benefits

- **Beneficiaries:** Lottery profits support a wide variety of good causes and are allocated differently in each jurisdiction.
